This project, born of a simple dream by four passionate young people, has exceeded our wildest expectations. Together, we proved that solidarity and determination can move mountains, even for a team with no previous experience.

The sum of **CHF 47,850** raised for the **CanSEARCH** Foundation is just one of the tangible results of this project. It's about building a committed intergenerational community, united by the conviction that every gesture counts, and that together, nothing is impossible.

We belong to a generation that masters communication tools like second nature. But this year, we've also discovered the immense power of words, ideas and deeds. **This network we're weaving is not just a social network : it's a human, vibrant network, through which we want to spread essential values such as mutual aid, commitment, the need to be informed, to understand, and to mobilize.**

But this is just the beginning

Play to Save is still in its infancy. The Tennesis Tournament: a founding success

On September 14 and 15, 2024, we took a decisive step forward with the organization of the **Tennesis Tournament, our very first event**. This tournament brought together eight of the best under-18 tennis players in Romandy at the Tennis club des Eaux-Vives, offering the public in attendance a high-level competition and a moment of sharing around a cause that is more than important: the fight against pediatric cancer.

From the outset, our objective was clear: to combine sporting performance with a commitment to solidarity. To achieve this, we mobilized all our resources to ensure the smooth running of the tournament, from logistics to communications, including the search for partners and the implementation of an effective awareness-raising strategy.

Impact in numbers

The response to the event exceeded all our expectations:

Amount raised for the CanSEARCH Foundation: CHF 47,850.

- **200,000** views on our Instagram reels
- **89,000** accounts reached on Instagram
- **5,000** profile visits and 500 new followers in one month
- **1,200** views on our website
- **87** broadcasts of our commercial on the Léman Bleu channel


